We have had a parent representative step down from our Site Based Decision Making Council. We are seeking a new parent to fill this space. I hope you'll consider running for our school council or encourage a friend to do so. In Kentucky, each

school has a council composed of the principal, elected teachers, and elected parents who make many of the most important decisions about how their school will work. The council is a wonderful chance to learn about our school, work closely with teachers, and help make our school even more successful than it is now. The parent members of the council are elected by parents. They receive training and will serve from July 1, 2019-June 30, 2020. If you are interested in running for the SBDM council, please notify the PTA. Nomination forms can be found in the school office or contact the PTA to email it. They are due to Amy Nitschke, PTA in the OFFICE no later than 3:30 pm September 9, 2019. If you know someone who would be a good candidate, please encourage that person to run. The election will be held September 10, 2019 after school at the General PTA meeting and volunteer training. If you will have a child enrolled at Piner Elementary School next year, you are eligible to vote in this election. (This includes parents, step-parents, and foster parents. Legal guardians are also eligible to vote if the child lives in their home.) I urge every parent to participate in this important decision about the future of our children's school.

Results will be posted on September 11, 2019 at 9:00AM in the school office. Please plan to be present for this important event. Thank you for your interest in our school, and please let me know if you have questions.
